D2D Details:

Entry: \$80/team w/\$20 optional big fish. **Pre-entry suggested due to 30 boat limit.**

Payouts: One (1) position/5 boats up to 3 pay positions. Paybacks are 90% Tournament and 100% big fish.
30 boat field example: 1st \$1080/ 2nd \$750/ 3rd 330/ Big Fish \$600

Team : A D2D tournament angler team is defined as the registered and paid entry of a boat captain and his/her registered tournament partners, with no more than four anglers comprising any team for any single tournament. No more than 6 rods may be used at any one time and **no more than 30 boats will be allowed at any tournament.**

Fish Limit: 5 fish/boat (IA events) - Out of state events will follow state law and will be announced prior to event. All fish must be caught on rod and reel from boat and **weighed alive.**

Take Off: Take off will be determined by boat number drawing and released in safe increments.

Livewells: All fish must be held in an on-board aerated livewell which will be checked prior to takeoff.

State Law: All local fishing laws will take precedent over any rules.

Sportsmanship: All teams must display high standards of sportsmanship and ethical conduct. Bad sportsmanship and/or cheating will not be tolerated and will be subject to disqualification of tournament and potentially all future D2D events. Any dispute must be submitted in writing to tournament director within 5 minutes of closing scales. All decisions by tournament director are final.

Tie Breakers: Tie breakers (Tournament & Championship Points) will be decided by number of fish, then big fish and finally by coin flip if required.

Series Champions: D2D will award a series championship package to the team with the highest points total for the best 4 of 6 events. A sponsor's prize package as well as traveling trophy will be awarded to the team of the year. Points will be awarded to the top 10 teams weighing fish at each event from 10-1.

Event Prizes: Top three teams will win tournament money, trophies and sponsor's prize packages. 4th & 5th place finishing teams will also receive sponsor's prize package.

D2D Loyalty Program: Teams fishing at least 4 tournaments will be eligible for an end of the season drawing for a guided day of fishing at a destination fishery. Does **not** include any costs associated with travel to and from destination.

D2D Perfect: Teams who fish all 6 events will be eligible for a drawing for a pair (2) of MGF Custom Catfish Rods.

D2D Banquet: D2D will have an end of the season banquet to celebrate fishing, family and friends. This banquet is open to all D2D participants as well anyone interested in joining us for future events. **2018 Banquet will be Saturday February 24, 2018 at 7pm at Rube's Steakhouse in Waukee. Please RSVP prior to February 21, 2018.**
